By taking part in Christingle this year, you can enjoy the warmth of this wonderful celebration Each piece of the Christingle holds special symbolism to help children understand the importance of Jesus at Christmas time.

The orange represents the world, The red ribbon symbolises the love and blood of Christ, The sweets and dried fruit represent all of God's creations, The lit candle represents Jesus' light in the world, bringing hope to people living in darkness. Refreshments will be served after the service.



#### **VOLUNTEERS NEEDED**

Whether you are retired and looking to keep busy or a parent with spare time whilst the children are at Conservation school or maybe a student looking for work experience, then the **Churches Conservation Trust (CCT)** 

has a volunteering opportunity to suit you. With 20 churches in Suffolk alone, all CCT churches are Grade II listed or above and most are open and ready for visitors all year round. The CCT is the national charity protecting historic churches at risk, repairing the damage from sometime years of neglect and then working with local communities to bring them alive again.

Volunteers are critical to the CCT's ability to care for, open and promote these often hidden treasures and roles including stewarding, event organising, fundraising, as well as practical roles such as cleaning and gardening. The need is for new volunteers to help ensure that these churches are open, used and there for future generations. Being a volunteer will give you the opportunity to meet likeminded people, learn new skills and even advance your career.

All Saints in Icklingham is one of Suffolk's most remarkable medieval churches which was built largely in the fourteenth century although it is of Norman origin. We are looking for volunteers and will be organising a cleaning day next Spring, it will also be a good opportunity to share ideas on how you would like to use this space.

During December there will be a Christmas Memory Tree in All Saints where visitors are encouraged to leave a name of a loved one, past or present, on a decoration and hang it on the tree. The Memory Tree will be in the church throughout December and for twelve days after Christmas.

LifeLink, which started in Haverhill and has also launched in Brandon and Mildenhall, is a free service for anyone over 16 years old and it is already busy. Benefits include: meeting new people and developing new friendships, feeling healthier and fitter, learning new skills volunteering and developina employability skills. This can lead to improved sense of wellbeing, leading to better physical and mental

The LifeLink Coordinators, coach participants on a oneto-one basis, working together to find ways for each person to improve their wellbeing and meet their needs by connecting them to social activities, clubs, groups and local services. By introducing suitable local services, groups, clubs or activities, each individual's social and practical needs can be supported and LifeLink will help, every step of the way.

Getting involved is easy. People can self-refer to the service, or ask a friend, supporter, GPs or other professional to help them to make a referral. Simply call the local LifeLink Coordinator to find out more and get involved.



What is The CCT **Churches Conservation Trust** This is the national charity protecting Conservation historic churches at risk. As a small charity with 350 historic churches to care for donations are vital. We spend millions each year protecting these wonderful buildings for future generations to enjoy. This work comes at a price - every year we must raise an additional £1.5 million just for essential repairs.

We attract almost 2 million visitors a year.

Established under Ecclesiastical Law on 1 April 1969 the charity receives its churches in the form of 'vestings' from the Church Commissioners. All the CCT's churches remain consecrated and are often used for occasional worship.

The CCT works with local people to bring historic churches back into the heart of the community and use as a social, tourism, educational or cultural resource. The CCT's care of Grade I and II\* buildings has given it an international reputation in heritage conservation and regeneration.

#### **PERKY TURKEY SOUP**

A warming spicy turkey soup a great use of Christmas leftovers - happy Boxing Day!

- 1 tbsp olive oil
- 1 large onion, halved and sliced into thin strips
- 1 red pepper, seeded and sliced into thin strips
- 2 tsp ground coriander
- 1 tsp chilli flakes
- 3 tbsp basmati rice or long grain rice
- 11/2 litres hot turkey or chicken stock

250g/9oz turkey meat, cut into thin strips (leg meat will have the most flavour)

410g can chickpeas, drained and rinsed a handful of fresh coriander/parsley roughly chopped

Heat the oil in a large pan, add the onion and fry for 5 minutes or so, stirring every now and then until it starts to soften.

To make the soup, add the red pepper, ground coriander, chilli and rice and stir round the pan for about a minute. Pour in the hot stock, stir in the turkey and chickpeas and season well. Bring to the boil, cover and simmer for 8-10 minutes, until the vegetables and rice are tender. Stir in the coriander or parsley and it's ready. Enjoy!

(Or the soup may now be cooled and frozen for up to 1 month.) Extras to try - Sizzle some chopped bacon with the onions. Pour in a splash of dry sherry before adding the stock. Any canned pulses can replace the chickpeas. Throw in some chopped sprouts – either cooked or raw. For extra zing, squeeze in a little lemon juice at the end.




