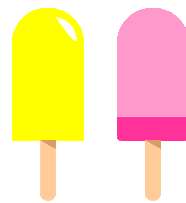

PUBLIC FORUM PC Luke Williams gave an overview of what is happening in the area to tackle the anti-social traffic issues. The Countywide enforcement team (1Sgt & 6 Officers) had been in the village the weekend of 27/28 March, most of the users on the ancient byway were legal and entitled to use the ancient byway. And research in the last 15 months the reports have spiked. Although he understood the issues we are having, he also said that we need to manage expectations and understand that resources are limited. Also, that it was imperative that the public needed to continue to report issues as this would also help build a bigger picture and would support the next steps available. It was agreed that it would take multiple agencies to work together to tackle the issue and a meeting would be arranged where all agencies could be in attendance to discuss the next steps.

SUFFOLK DOG DAY After two years of missing you all at Suffolk Dog Day, the team are thrilled to announce that we will be returning to Helmingham Hall on the 31st July with an event bigger and better than ever before. Our return will be part of Festival of Suffolk Jubilee celebrations in Suffolk. This is no ordinary day in the doggy diary, but a day to celebrate our furry friends in all their guises. Enjoy a great day out with your dogs, family & friends. There are fun dog classes with great prizes, agility, dog scurry, lots of attractions and trade stands to keep everyone entertained.

Highlights include: Fun Dog classes for everyone to enter with great prizes, Helmingham Ring, Agility Ring, Suffolk Ring, Activities for you and your dog. Children's activities. More than 50 stalls selling everything from dog accessories to cheese, There is a Catering Village, Entertainments & demonstrations. What's more, included within the ticket price is entry to Helmingham Gardens.

Suffolk Dog Day is organised by Suffolk Community Foundation to support their work throughout the County. FREE parking FREE programme Entry to Helmingham Hall Gardens On the day itself, all Dog Class entries are £3 (paid for at the Registration Tent) and all entries for our fun and fast "Have a Go" zone activities are £2 a go, payable to the team at the entrance to each ring. No advance ticket purchase required – all tickets are available to buy on the gate on the day Please note: **We will now be able to accept credit and debit card payments on the gate.** We love to see puppies at Suffolk Dog Day, but they should have had all their vaccinations – if you're puppy is under 6 months old, the Registration team may ask to see proof of your dog's vaccinations document All dogs must be kept on a lead at all time

This easy playdough recipe takes 5 minutes to prep and 5 minutes to make. The playdough will last for months! It's super soft, stretchy and non-toxic for kids. All you need is 1 cup flour, 2 tsp cream of tartar, 1/2 cup salt, 1 tbsp vegetable oil, 1 cup water & food colouring. Method : Mix food colouring with your water in a large saucepan then add the vegetable oil. Mix. Add the all the dry ingredients to your saucepan and mix in well.

Cook over low to medium heat, once it starts to form a ball together and looks fully cooked, take off the heat. Let the dough cool.

Once cool, knead the dough for 5 minutes to make the dough soft. If your dough is not soft, continue kneading for another 5 minutes. If you find it is still too dry add a little bit more oil and knead in. Store in an air-tight container in a cool place.
