PUBLIC FORUM PC Luke Williams gave an overview of what is happening in the area to tackle the anti-social traffic issues. The Countywide enforcement team (1Sgt & 6 Officers) had been in the village the weekend of 27/28 March, most of the users on the ancient byway were legal and entitled to use the ancient byway. And research in the last 15 months the reports have spiked. Although he understood the issues we are having, he also said that we need to manage expectations and understand that resources are limited. Also, that it was imperative that the public needed to continue to report issues as this would also help build a bigger picture and would support the next steps available. It was agreed that it would take multiple agencies to work together to tackle the issue and a meeting would be arranged where all agencies could be in attendance to discuss the next steps.

Enjoy a great day out with your dogs, family & friends. There are fun dog classes with great prizes, agility, dog scurry, lots of attractions and trade stands to keep everyone entertained.

All dogs must be kept on a lead at all time

This easy playdough recipe takes 5 minutes to prep and 5 minutes to make. The playdough will last for months! It's super soft, stretchy and nontoxic for kids. All you need is 1 cup flour, 2 tsp cream of tartar, 1/2 cup salt, 1 tbsp vegetable oil, 1 cup water & food colouring. Method: Mix food colouring with your water in a large saucepan then add the vegetable oil. Mix. Add the all the dry ingredients to your saucepan and mix in well.

Cook over low to medium heat, once it starts to form a ball together and looks fully cooked, take off the heat. Let the dough cool.

Once cool, knead the dough for 5 minutes to make the dough soft. If your dough is not soft, continue kneading for another 5 minutes. If you find it is still too dry add a little bit more oil and knead in.




